

## **Humber Night Challenge 2012**

The Tribune Trust sponsored Humber Night Challenge Competition will be held over the night of 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> of March 2012 at Brantingham Park, Elloughton, East Riding of Yorkshire.

The event is open to teams of young people aged 13 to 17 years who working in a team of five will navigate through the lower Yorkshire Wolds, through woods and dales over a 12 mile route carrying out tasks at a number of check points. The event will run all night with teams starting at 15 intervals. A maximum of 32 teams will compete involving 160 young people.

Each team will be accompanied by an independent walking supervisor all volunteers.

The event is being organised by the Lifestyle Team of Humberside Police in partnership with the Humberside Fire and Rescue Service, Coastguard Service and Humberside and Lincolnshire Orienteering Club. (HALO).
