'Trust Support for Withernsea Army Cadets'

At 7.0 PM on Thursday 3 November Hugh Bethell, DL, Chairman of the Tribune Trust and Director Geoff Ogden will attend the Withernsea Army Cadet Detachment venue in the resort to present a cheque for £1,000 as an award to the Corps.

The money will be used to fund over 20 cadets receiving training in interview techniques and broadcasting by the manager and staff members of the Withernsea based 'Seaside Radio' station. The cadets will then interview members of the armed services and British Legion members in the town about their experiences recently and over many previous years.

The interviews will be broadcast on air by the radio station in the run up to Armistice Day and Remembrance Sunday.

The event on Thursday evening will also be attended by the Mayor of Withernsea, Army Cadet Force Commander for Humberside and South Yorkshire, Lt Col Crowley of 4 Yorks, members of the British Legion, Manager of Seaside Radio FM, Justin McCartney and members of the local community who have served their country.

Director of the Tribune Trust Geoff Ogden, said "This is a brilliant and moving initiative planned by Seaside Radio and the army cadets. Not only does it allow young people to understand the sacrifices made by those serving their country it allows young people and older members of the community to work together in an atmosphere of respect. The trustees are delighted to support it."
